**GIGANTOS** was getting his second start off the shelf July 23<sup>rd</sup>; he was fanned wide on the first turn then made a premature rush for the outside on the second turn to get the lead; he was run down in the lane but protected second against a troubled third place finisher; that event points him out as a contender.

**BANKURA** debuted July 28<sup>th</sup> at six furlongs and was not a factor; he was in a quickly run race taken by a dominant speed winner; he now stretches to a route.

**SCRAM DIGGITY** seems to be progressing; he had a pace presence when the middle fractions were quickening July 23<sup>rd</sup> but he faltered late in the same race where Gigantos was second; he has since worked in 1.01.2.

**RIMAL AL SAHARA** is looking to recover from his letdown performance in a seven furlong race two outings ago; for a new trainer last time, he was hoping to get on turf and that event went on Poly track and he couldn't keep up; he reports a quick work on turf in 59.4 since that last race.

**CAREER HIGH** had his seasonal bow July 4<sup>th</sup> on turf at seven furlongs and was delayed and finally finished eighth of fourteen; he ran well enough in routes last autumn to suggest he can be a factor her.

**JAMES STREET** is a runner with considerable size and he did not break well in his debut July 28<sup>th</sup> then was bothered by another runner and his cause was lost; for this second start, he goes farther and adds lasix

**BIG TIME** was bumped at the break in his seasonal bow July 25<sup>th</sup> and that seemed to be excuse enough; he was competitive in a route race last October.

**ARCHON** is bred to be a thorough stayer; he had a couple of starts last autumn but didn't progress at that time; he does possess some late power and should be progressing; this will be his seasonal bow and it comes around two turns from the widest post.

**NICE LADY** came back on a very quick return July 14<sup>th</sup> and had a peak performance at seven furlongs; she rallied past some tired runners and finished second beaten a half length; she now extends in distance and gets a break in the weights with apprentice Moreno now aboard.

**GO WEST G T GO** showed bravery July 16<sup>th</sup> when she won at a route by splitting horses at the top of the stretch under good handling by Justin Stein for Abraham Katryan; the late pace in that event sagged; the runner up came back to win on Sunday.

**PRECIOUS AS JADE** has been on the edges in recent events; last time when Interregnum was six lengths the best, this one was a distant third; she carries a significant weight.

**INTERREGNUM** has already won big in this classification and that came July 25<sup>th</sup> in a race that featured a quick early pace but faltering late fractions were obvious; she drew away from that inflated group; she came back to work smartly in 1.00.2 for trainer John Le Blanc Jr; she meets potentially tougher here.

**DIVORSKY** was not a factor last time in the same race where Interregnum was six lengths the best.

**NOT A LADY** is trying to make a distance adjustment here after a runner up finish for the minimum at six and a half furlongs last time where she closed strongly on the rail only to lose narrowly.

**SELEMBAO** has been preferred in her two winning races; she came off the shelf June 20<sup>th</sup> and seemed to thrive because of the freshness; she now returns from another freshening for Catherine Day-Phillips; she prepped August 7<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.3; Jones will now be the rider.

**D'COUNTRY** is a high velocity filly who has made a couple of experiments at route distances here; she was third in the Ontario Lassie as a juvenile behind Milwaukee Appeal; she comes off a sharp second place finish in this classification June 27<sup>th</sup> when traveling just six furlongs; she had a positive prep August 9<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.2 for Josie Carroll.

**MOST UNUSUAL** a debut runner for Josie Carroll was an auction purchase earlier this season; he is by Aragorn who captured Grade 1 victories on turf in California and then was second in the Breeders' Cup Mile just in front of Badge Of Silver, the sire of Call For Silver; he prepped July 28<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.3.

**AINTOFLYSONME** has not been a factor in any Poly track races to date but did work quickly in a recent turf move in 59.1; he does have turf in his pedigree.

**REPORT CARD TIME** was arguably the best runner last time but couldn't keep a straight course when rallying in the stretch; he galloped out far in front of that field for maiden \$40,000 at five furlongs on Poly track; he now shifts over to turf and does have one turf winning sibling.

**CALL FOR SILVER** is by the popular Badge Of Silver who already has six juvenile winners including, Silverleo, a recent winner here on turf at Woodbine; this one has been traded about at auction; his dam is well related for turf and has already produced a couple of turf winners; he prepped on turf August 1<sup>st</sup> in 1.01.2 for Mark Casse.

**JADRAN** is certainly bred for turf being by Artie Schiller, a winner of the Breeders' Cup in the Mile in 2005; he prepped August 6<sup>th</sup> in 49.

**POWER GRID** a homebred for Robert S. Evans, debuts for Mark Frostad; he is by Dynaformer, a significant source of stamina and turf; this one is from a dam that did well as a two year old and she has produced a couple of turf winners; he has had two recent works on turf including a move August 8<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.3.

**OCCASIONAL VIEW** a homebred for Augustin Stable, is by Silver Deputy and is from the family of Archers Bay; he worked August 2<sup>nd</sup> in 48.4 for MacDonald Benson.

**MIAMI ROCKSTAR** debuts for Michael McDonald and was an auction purchase earlier this season in Florida; he is by Tale Of The Cat and from a dam that has produced a turf winner; he worked on turf July 30<sup>th</sup> in 1.03.

**SEETHING** was in the Clarendon Stakes last time where he pressed the pace then faltered; he now runs on turf for the initial time.

**CHER DINI** is a homebred and debuts for Mark Frostad; he is by Bernardini, a winner of the Grade 1 Jockey Club Gold Cup and his dam did produce Street Sounds and Silver Highlight and both enjoyed the turf; he worked on turf August 8<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.3.

**FAVRINI** a debut runner for Dan Vella, has turf top and bottom in his pedigree and worked on the lawn August 1<sup>st</sup> in 48.4.

**BEAR'S GODFATHER** an auction purchase last September, debuts for Bear Stables and is by North Light, a winner at the highest level in Europe; he worked recently in 49 for Mike De Paulo.

**TOP PIT BOSS** was on turf last time and made a middle move but couldn't sustain it; he has since worked in 1.00 on Poly track.

**MOSTLY MAGIC** is one of two entered for Dan Vella and he was only sixth of ten on turf last time.

**JUSTICE IS SERVED** was on turf July 17<sup>th</sup> but faltered; he has come back to work on turf in 59.4.

**DANAHER** was second on turf recently in a peak effort behind Stormy Rush who was entered for Thursday.

**MISS TAGGART** chased a key winner in her debut then scored second time out when stretched to six furlongs for Josie Carroll; she had a good response in that last event; she had worked very well in preparation for that last win.

**MISTRESS GALLOP** had an eventful debut June 19<sup>th</sup>; she opted for the good footing on the rail but got shut off; she started up again and won at 33-1 for Darwin Banach; both the sixth and eighth place finishes have come back to win; she came back to work August 8<sup>th</sup> on the training track in 59.2; she is a daughter of Victory Gallop and that sire will be entering the Hall of Fame on Thursday.

**I FLY HIGH** made a dash on the rail when that footing was offering preferred going July 17<sup>th</sup> and she made it home by 1 ½ lengths; she came back to work with Dos Ramos aboard August 7<sup>th</sup> in 1.01.2 for Sam Di Pasquale; she is advancing.

**WONDERLANDBYNIGHT** has had an eventful time in Chicago and was credited with a second maiden victory June 27<sup>th</sup> in a five furlong race; she took over in the stretch; she has since been freshened and she has been getting ready with works at home and prepped July 31<sup>st</sup> in 1.02bg for her new trainer Larry Rivelli who has had success at this meeting.

**MIMI'S MISSY** looks to be a recognizable threat; she won her second start by a wide margin and the third place finisher came back with a big win; most recently, she was overwhelmed in the My Dear Stakes; she stalled on the rail while the heavy favourite won and when she finally removed herself from the rail, she did some running in the stretch; she worked August 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1.01.1; Alex Solis has the mount.

**I'M NO TOY** was sharp to win her debut in an upper claiming event but wasn't a factor in the Shady Well Stakes as she moved on the rail; the runner up has come back to win an added money race.

**GOLD XCHANGE** must deal with the inside post today; he made a six wide bid in the stretch last time and rallied to be second beaten just a half length against some of these while traveling this distance at this price.

**JIMMY THE ROOFER** reportedly had some difficulty leaving the gate July 23<sup>rd</sup> in his seasonal bow; he was heavily backed for that event and recovered to be fifth beaten only 1 ½ lengths; apprentice Moreno gets the call here.

**DEHERE THE AMIGO** has not been a threat through the stretch in his three career starts; he hit the bottom level last time at six furlongs; he now goes seven furlongs.

**BARDI'S AT NOON** got a July 17<sup>th</sup> seasonal bow and he was plunged to the lowest level; he finished sixth of fourteen; for this second start of the year, lasix is added and the blinkers are off.

**BREATHITT** was closing well at seven furlongs two starts ago and finished third; most recently at six furlongs, he was understandably too late with his bid; he gets back to seven furlongs now.

**KNEBWORTH** he had an awkward break from the gate in his July 23<sup>rd</sup> race where he took the big plunge to the lowest level; he went to the rail where that location was offering good footing and he lasted in front until late and then finished on the edges; his middle post gives him a chance to improve.

**GEIGER LOVE** a debut runner for Norm De Souza, is from a dam that has produced four winners and some of them have enjoyed Poly track; he worked July 18<sup>th</sup> in 47.4 getting ready.

**VALE OF AVOCA** takes the final local drop, in now for the minimum; he was sixth of eleven for \$19,000 at this distance last time; he worked recently on the training track in 48.3.

**EDMONDSBYTHESEA** debuted at skimpy odds July 23<sup>rd</sup> for the Terry Jordan stable and finished eighth of eleven while Cool Consigliere was much better in second; he was lasix free for that opening run; for this second start, lasix is now added and that has been a profitable angle; he stretches from five to seven furlongs.

**LASTCALLFORALCOHOL** had a busy spring time but has been freshened since June 17<sup>th</sup> when out of the money; he drops back to the lowest level and goes seven furlongs.

**COOL CONSIGLIERE** shortened to only five furlongs last time and was second best with a rally; he now goes seven furlongs and has the benefits of a recent work in 1.02.3.

**CLOVER CREST** had a near impossible post position last time, yet, pressed the pace at this price and distance and finished fourth with Breathitt in third; he gets another outward post position here.

**NO WAY HOSE A** debuted for \$25,000 last December but wasn't a factor while going lasix free; for this seasonal bow, he drops down and adds lasix.

**WATERCOLORMEMORIES** has not been a factor through the stretch in recent races and gets a tough post for this race.

**LONE SPRINT** was in for \$19,000 at a route last time and finished sixth beaten about six lengths; he takes the drop back down to the lowest position.

**PARK LANE** stalled in recent events; he now stretches from six to seven furlongs and puts the blinkers on.

**AWISHYORHEARTMAKES** was not a factor July 18<sup>th</sup> when facing the third place finisher, Executive Sherri; she stretches from a sprint to a route.

**EXECUTIVE SHERRI** went long three outings ago and was third behind a key winner Secret Skills who has come back to do well; most recently for the minimum in a six and a half furlong event, she made a quick move on the outside and finished third.

**MYAH'S FLIGHT** was no factor in a sprint two starts ago when Executive Sherri was much better in third; most recently, she stretched to a route and made a premature rush at the top of the stretch to get the lead then was overtaken and finished third with Zippy Lady in second; she has had a busy schedule but has been given more of a freshening coming to this event; Carignan now rides.

**MISS MCDREAMY** can certainly be considered on her big effort two outings ago when she broke her maiden for the minimum going this distance; most recently, she went nine furlongs in a race that had a faltering late pace and she didn't stay the trip; she has since had a work in 1.01.1.

**ZIPPY LADY** was doing her best running through the stretch July 23<sup>rd</sup> but was overtaken by another runner who came from her outside and she had to settle for second in this classification; she had some of these behind her.

**PUTALITLEBOOGYINIT** gained gradually last time but was no match for the runner up Zippy Lady or the third place finisher, Myah's Flight.

**BEATRICE M.** will be adjusting to route racing here after three sprints to open this campaign and she has been on the edged each time; she hit the lowest level last time when third; she had exposure to route racing in turf events last year.

**ROMANTIC ERA** benefitted from the bias with her off the pace move July 25<sup>th</sup> and was much the best for maiden \$11,500 under good handling from Wilson for John Charalambous.

**PERFECT RESOLVE** rated early then moved in the middle stages only to hang at the end finishing a distant fourth against non winners of three last time; now she faces non winners of two.

**IMANUPTOWNGIRL** was a winner going long for maiden \$11,500 two outings ago; most recently against some of these, she angled out for the stretch drive and finished fourth with Zippy Lady in second and Myah's Flight in third.

**ESCAPISM** ran a strong race July 11<sup>th</sup> to fight with three others on the pace and get the lead only to be passed at the last instant by two ralliers including the runner up, always Wildcatin' who is here; he was claimed from that event and comes back at the same price for his new conditioner, Tom Lough Jr.

**GRAND MOBIL** seemed to take a significant edge April 23<sup>rd</sup> when he returned from considerable time away to drop in for \$20,000 and win by four lengths at five furlongs; he has taken more time and comes back at the same price range after reporting a couple of recent preps for Sam Di Pasquale; he goes farther.

**BOADINI** dropped in for \$19,000 against non winners of two last time and in this category, he rushed on the pace but gave up many positions late as the favourite; the sixth place finisher from that race has come back to win big.

**CHILD O'MINE** is getting his first start since the spring when his form deteriorated; on his best day, he is a sharp pace contributor; he is in at a radically reduced evaluation here.

**DEVIL IN WILLIE** was in the slightly slower split July 30<sup>th</sup> when defeating maidens with a smart outside move; he now comes in against non winners of two and jumps in value.

**EYE OF THE EAGLE** was in the somewhat faster split of a race July 30<sup>th</sup> when breaking his maiden for the minimum and Devil In Willie was in the slower split; he now jumps in value.

**CAT LOVES THIS** had a sharp performance July 15<sup>th</sup> when coming off the shelf for his belated seasonal bow; he made a strong bid in mid stretch then hung at the last moment; he is up in value for this; he indicates a work July 28<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.1 getting ready.

**IF AND ALMOST** has had a busy recent schedule; at seven furlongs July 24<sup>th</sup>, he was a closing third in a nice try; most recently August 7<sup>th</sup>, he went around two turns and was in a pace chase against the front running winner who woke up; he yielded second prize late and settled for third; he goes just six furlongs here and apprentice Moreno takes over.

**ALWAYS WILDCATIN'** was far behind early in a race at six furlongs last time against three year olds for \$20,000 but he made up ground from the outside and was second beaten a half length by a winner dropping down and Escapism was third; he now comes in against non winners of two to face some older runners.

**SLEW'S KID** was in for the minium last time and made a move four wide and finished on the edges; he is up in value for this.

**ROYAL CHALLENGER** attracted a claim when dropped for \$20,000 July 31<sup>st</sup> and he was out of the money; he has a challenge of a different kind here extending to nine furlongs and going to turf.

**ICE BEAR** had a flat performance July 11<sup>th</sup> in the Ontario Jockey Stakes at seven furlongs; he had run with more intensity in the King Edward at a mile; Da Silva now takes over and he extends to nine furlongs on turf seeking a breakthrough victory.

**RAHY'S ATTORNEY** did not respond in the yielding footing in the Grade 2 Nijinsky Stakes last time and was fifth of nine behind the upset winner, Windward Islands; he had run more prominently in the King Edward at a flat mile; he must stretch back to nine furlongs now but is in against much more reachable company in this restricted event; he worked well on turf August 8<sup>th</sup> in 58.2.

**GENIUS KINSHASA** looks like an up and coming marathon runner; he was in the Singspiel and finished a distant fourth against Spice Route but stayed well; he is going only nine furlongs here; he worked August 6<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.3 for Vito Armata.

**WOODBOURNE** had a game performance at seven furlongs on turf for new interests last time; he raced along the portable rail and was beaten late by a winner that came to the outside; his challenge here is stretching to nine furlongs against this somewhat better group.

**SLIGOVITZ** will now go under the direction of Sean Smullen after a seventh place finish in the Dominion Day; he has tried to rebuild after some good works both on Poly track and the training turf.

**ZARROC** competed in the Singspiel Stakes July 4<sup>th</sup> and was only seventh and no match for Genius Kinshasa who was fourth in that event; he is facing easier here.

**PORT STANLEY** has developed into a positive staying type; he was on turf two outings ago and finished fourth with Zarroc in second; he worked August 8<sup>th</sup> on Poly track in the good time of 1.00.1.

**KIRKLAND LAKE** has now won three in a row; when he beat three year olds for straight claiming \$60,000 at six furlongs on Poly track last time, he was allowed to go at the generous price of 5-1; he committed to a speed style on preferred footing on the rail; he now sees turf for the initial time.

**ARROW'S CONQUEST** is beautifully bred for the turf and now gets on to the lawn after consecutive Poly track wins; most recently July 9<sup>th</sup>, he made all of the running; he encounters other sharp speed here in The Great McGee and Merkabah and may well get a stalking trip this time.

**THE GREAT MCGEE** was determined with a speed approach in this category last time while traveling seven furlongs; he gave up the lead reluctantly and finished third with Woodbourne in second and that one was in race eight today; Merkabah also prefers a speed style.

**AUTEUR** is a closing type on his best performance; he moved prematurely from far on the outside last time then hung, a trait he has indicated in recent races; a move is made to Contreras.

**HALLWAY** came off the shelf July 24<sup>th</sup> for a race here on Poly track at the second allowance level and wasn't a factor; he is a two time turf winner and also has three shares on the lawn and now moves to that footing.

**RED LEADER** got a belated seasonal bow July 18<sup>th</sup> at seven furlongs on turf and was on the edges with a gain between rivals; he gets more room with which to work here stretching to a mile; he did win at a mile last summer.

**R SHINING HOPE** is a three year old who is developing now; he was third in the Charlie Barley Stakes last time; he had a prompt work August 6<sup>th</sup> in 59.4 getting ready to go against older runners.

**EL GRAN BRETT** is getting his first start since December of 2008 and he was in winning form at that juncture; he now goes for trainer Gary Chudobiak and has been prepared at Fort Erie.

**MERKABAH** has won both career races on turf; his career was launched at Gulfstream Park; he doubled up here July 16<sup>th</sup> at nine furlongs with an aggressive stalking trip; with The Great McGee likely to have speed; that one represents a pace target; he prepped August 8<sup>th</sup> in 49.2 getting ready.

**TIERRA DEL TIGRE** did not react on yielding ground in the Nijinsky Stakes last time at long odds; he did win on Poly track earlier this season for his lone win of this campaign; he is a one time winner on turf and that was a maiden score in September of 2009.

**GUIPAGO** exits the Singspiel Stakes where he wasn't a factor because of the dominance of the winner; he finished sixth and in fourth was Genius Kinshasa who was entered in the previous event today; he has a chance to improve in this spot with a concentrated run from off the pace.

**JESTER'S BID** did well to win his seasonal bow June 24<sup>th</sup> in her first race since last July; she also raced well July 18<sup>th</sup> in this category at six furlongs when staying on to be third beaten three lengths.

**G T'S GONE DANCING** was at seven furlongs last time where she was the early front runner but she faltered out of the money.

**PEPLOE** tried an added money race July 25<sup>th</sup> at Fort Erie that came off turf and she wasn't a factor; she is seeking her initial share of this campaign; she worked recently in 1.01.4.

**MOLINARO JOYFUL** has been freshened a month since a race July 18<sup>th</sup> when out of the money and non threatening; she did have a significant speed work August 6<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.1 for Vito Armata.

**ENCORE TOO** was out of the money on turf last time, yet, had won on the lawn the time before; the last time she was on Poly track, she was narrowly beaten by a key winner, Princess Chelsea; she had a fast work August 6<sup>th</sup> in 1.00.4.

**LADY BOUDREAU** worked August 8<sup>th</sup> in preparation for this in 1.00.3 for Mike Wright; in her latest, she got off the rail but the winner was just too good at skimpy odds and relegated her to second.

**NO MORE CATS** won big two outings ago for a maiden score but most recently, experimented with added money company in the Passing Mood on turf and finished at the back; the seventh place finisher, Miss Reginella, has come back to win on Poly track.

**PORT WINE** has improved significantly since moving over to turf; she won two outings ago; she finished fourth beaten just four and a half lengths on very firm turf in the Passing Mood; a switch is now made to Wilson.

**GLORY BAY** was not a factor in a five furlong race from the inside post July 9<sup>th</sup>; she offered only early speed.

**GIN QUEEN** has been in quite tough in a series of races; she was out of the money in the Passing Mood Stakes last time; tracing back to her seasonal bow on Poly track, she went well.

**LUCKY MELISSA** was heavily bet in her debut but faltered; second time out with Sutherland aboard, she had a different approach from farther off the pace and had some maturity in that event to provide a winning rally; she galloped out well; she now races beyond five furlongs for the initial time.

**EXECUTIVE PICK** was attracting plenty of betting support last summer and concluded her juvenile campaign October 16<sup>th</sup> with a victory at a route; she tries just six furlongs in this return for Kevin Attard; she prepped recently in 1.02.3 getting ready.

**DANCIN ANNIE** was a surprise second when moved to turf August 1<sup>st</sup>; it was her first exposure to the lawn and she provided a good rally; Fraser has been named today with this move to Poly track.

**NOCOOKIESFORPAPA** was in a key race June 17<sup>th</sup> and faltered out of the money in fifth; the winner came back to be second in the Passing Mood and both the second and third place finishers have come back to win big; she now gets in against reachable runners in hopes of recapturing her best.

**BONCHICA BONBONBON** was at Fort Erie last time to post a maiden win at six furlongs and she rated and then drew away; she is hoping to carry that momentum back here where she seeks her initial in the money finish on Poly track this year.

**MOONLIGHT DESIRE** was used for positioning last time when departing turf and going to Poly track and she finished on the edges with Jester's Bid a length better in third; she has been freshened.
