LORD JUSTICE took charge soon after the start, set the pace in hand along the rail to the top of the stretch and edged away under steady right hand urging. HAITIAN SENSATION was under a firm hold just behind the winner while saving ground on the backstretch, awaited room along the inside on the turn, angled out in midstretch and finished willingly for the place. TAP MAN pressed the winner from outside to the top of the stretch and held well to gain a share. A claim of foul lodged against the runner-up for interference in the stretch was disallowed. MR. AGAIN saved ground while trailing to the turn, swerved out in upper stretch and rallied mildly in the middle of the stretch. CELLAR DWELLER settled in good position along the rail for six furlongs, angled three wide in upper stretch and lacked a late response. MAJHOOD was under a firm hold while a bit rank on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs, swung four wide at the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing bid. SIR JOHN chased three wide to the turn and gave way.
