CRACK THEPAT pressed the pace outside EXPEDITION, took over from that rival leaving the turn, then drew clear under steady urging. STAR VALUE chased the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while closing to prove second best. WILCAT SAILOR chased the pace into the stretch, then tired. EXPEDITION broke awkwardly, set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner and gave way in the drive. RAISING TIMBER well placed while saving ground, faltered in the drive. CLOSE RANGE tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and faded. STORM WIND off slowly, was outrun. HOLY SPRING was never a factor.
