WENDY'S SANDY was unhurried, began a run between horses leaving the backstretch, came out three wide on the final turn, closed outside through the lane and was along in time. GO SWISH cleared early, stayed out from the inside and faltered. RUN LIGHTENING RUN lagged inside, came out between horses for the drive and finished with good energy. ZOARES LAND had position outside but lacked a rally. GOLDEN MUSTANG was slow to settle, raced wide around the final turn and finished willingly outside. SMOOTH KARMA wasn't far back between horse early, angled to the rail on the final turn then tired. DISGUISE tired outside. SOUP TO GO tired inside. GATEY'S BLUFF came out three wide on the final turn but failed to menace. JOE'S IRISH ECHO chased two wide to the far turn then stopped.
