Footnotes

GOLDEN MUSTANG lacked speed, circled five wide under a ride into the lane, closed determinedly under strong handling, took command inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear at the wire. OUR DIAMOND MINE , brushed at the break, vied two wide into the first turn then went clear after a quarter mile, set a rated pace two wide, drifted out leaving the three sixteenths marker, was collared past the furlong pole and gave way grudgingly. AMERICAN STEEL rated forwardly while saving ground, advanced inside leaving the three sixteenths marker, challenged just past the eighth pole then hung. LION'S SHARE vied early along the rail, shifted out to chase the leader down the backstretch, lodged a mild bid three eighths out, continued a solid presence to mid stretch then faded. GIN'S SOUR GIN lacked speed, raced between rivals leaving the three eighths pole the lacked a solid finish. CALL ME SONNY saved ground, made a mild run into the far turn then lacked any further response. INDIAN WAR , three wide, moved closer into the far turn, chased the pace around the final turn then tired in upper stretch. CHRISTIAN'S STAR , wide into the first turn, dropped back.
