ALTONA ROAD raced midpack, chased on the far turn, launched an all out drive and was up in time. PORT STANLEY raced off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the far turn, rallied and just got up for second. FULL THROTTLE led early in hand, set a reserved pace, was all out in the stretch but failed to stay in the final yards. HARVEST HOME stalked the pace, was hustled two-wide on the far turn then finished gamely along the inside. CARCILLO stalked the pace, chased on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. LANGARTIC stalked early but was through early and began to fade from late backstretch. DON VALENTINO raced midpack, saved ground but failed to menace. TARGET DATE raced well back, was bothered through the entire first turn by the loose horse, closed steadily on the backstretch, chased on the turn but was never a threat. KENSINGTON OVAL broke outward, was rated off the pace, tired at the far turn and faded. NAVAL STRIKE shied at the 1/4 and unseated his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT CONCERNING NAVAL STRIKE LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
